# Rules

- Use park at your own risk.
- Owners are legally responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) at all times.
- Dogs must be leashed while entering and exiting the park.
- Dog waste must be cleaned up by their owners IMMEDIATELY.
- Owners must be within the dog park and supervising their dog with leash readily available.
- Dog handlers must be at least 16 years of age.
- Puppies under 5 months, sick dogs, and dogs in heat are prohibited.
- Children under 4 feet tall are not allowed in the dog park.
- Dogs that exhibit dominant aggressive behavior, do not come when called, play too rough, or cannot control their barking must be removed from the park.
- Park is open from dawn until dusk.
- Dog training and other unrelated activities are prohibited inside the dog park.
- Dogs cannot be left alone. No more than 2 dogs per handler are permitted.
- Dogs must wear a collar with current vaccination tags and city dog license at all times.
- Owners are required to stop their dog(s) from digging and must fill any holes created.
- Water is provided outside of the dog park. Do not bring water bowls as they could spread the kennel cough virus.

### **Prohibited**

- All food/treats (human and dog)
- Bicycles, skates, skateboards, etc.
- Strollers
- Toys
- Glass containers
- Prona collars
- Smoking, tobacco products, alcohol



Dogs must wear a collar with current vaccination tags and a city dog license. We honor out of town licenses. If you need a Bettendorf license, stop by City Hall!
