SUMMER VOLLEYBALL The summer volleyball team registration forms will be available February 28th online at www.bettendorf.org/parks and also at the Life Fitness Center and the Bettendorf Community Center. The fee is \$110/team. The deadline for signing up a team is April 26th. 7th and 8th grade teams will play on Mondays, Freshman teams on Thursdays, Sophomore teams on Tuesdays, and Varsity teams on Wednesdays. It is an 8-week program that begins on Monday June 4th and will run through July 26th. The Wednesday matches will begin a week early (on May 30th) because July 4th is on a Wednesday in 2018. ADULT SPRING/SUMMER RECREATIONAL SOFTBALL LEAGUES Priority registration will start end of January for returning teams that played in 2017. New teams wanting into the league will register for remaining openings beginning in March, along with any returning teams who missed the priority registration. It will be a first come/first serve registration starting in March until spots are filled. Season will start at the end of April. There will be a team league fee and an ASA fee. Registration is done online at www.teamsideline.com/bettendorf. Scores and standings are viewed here, as well. Cost is \$445 for Men's and \$345 for Co-Ed, with a \$28 ASA fee for all teams. Men's leagues are offered on Mondays: C & D leagues/Tuesdays: D Leagues/Wednesdays: D Leagues. Men's play a 20 game double header scheduled season. Teams play the same team that night. There is a season ending tournament. Co-Ed leagues are offered on Thursdays: C & D leagues. Co-Ed leagues play a 15 single games season, with a season ending tournament. League winning teams receive t-shirts for all registered players and a team plaque. 2nd place teams receive a team plaque. Tournament champs and runner ups receive a team trophy.

MLB PITCH, HIT, & RUN EVENT Participate in this FREE exciting baseball and softball skills competition open to boys and girls ages 7-14. The competition is hosted by both Bettendorf and Davenport Parks and Recreation Departments at Crow Creek Park's 4-Plex Ballfields. Boys and girls compete separately at varying age levels. Showcase your pitching, hitting, and running abilities. The MLB-PHR program is intended to encourage youth participation and emphasize the "FUN" element of baseball. Since there is NO FEE, every child has the chance to participate. Participants will compete in each of the three components. If you win your age/gender division, you have a chance to keep advancing to the sectionals, team championships, and national championship finals! All competitions held after the sectionals will be held at a MLB stadium. Look for this event in April 2018!

DISC GOLF CLINICS Registrants will learn the basics of the sport of disc golf. The instructor is a professional disc golf player with years of experience. YOUTH BASEBALL/SOFTBALL TRAINING CAMPS NEW for 2018! These camps will now be offered on Saturday afternoons for a 6-week session for youth ages 6-11 yrs at the Community Center on Grant Street. Basic skills and drills will be performed each week. This is a recreational level camp for new or unskilled players, not intended for advanced players. COACH PITCH BASEBALL/SOFTBALL LEAGUES There are 2 different age divisions offered for each league. Teams are determined by schools and number of volunteer coaches. We rely solely on volunteer parents to coach these teams. (Less coaches = more kids per team) Please consider being a part of your child's experience and coach a team. Practices prior to and during the season are based on individual coaches. These are not guaranteed. Registration will begin in February and go through the end of March. Coaches' meetings will be held the first part of April. Season will start mid-May. This is a 6 game/week season. Rainouts are made up when feasible. Registration can be done online at www.bettendorf.org/register or in person at City Hall 1609 State Street. Baseball: 4/5 yr olds play on Mondays and 6/7 yr olds play on Wednesdays. Softball: 4/5 yr olds play on Tuesdays and 6/7 yr olds play on Thursdays. Games are played on Veteran's Fields 1 & 2 and Edgewood Field. Game times are 5:30 and 6:45. (Subject to change based on enrollment.) Bettendorf Parks & Rec reversible jerseys are required for this program.
