HONOR YOUR HERO

ELIGIBILITY

- Honorees must have served honorably or presently be serving on active duty.
- Honorees must be current or past residents of Bettendorf or have worked in the city.
- Honorees who are in good standing with a Veterans organization of Bettendorf are also eligible for inclusion.

RECOGNITION

Each Veteran entry may contain two lines with 30 characters per line. The \$225 cost includes the first 30 characters. Any additional characters are \$8 each. The name appears on the first line and may be followed by MIA, POW, KIA if desired. Line two is for branch affiliation and date served, or war/conflict designation.

The Bettendorf Veterans Memorial is a lasting tribute to the men and women who served our country honorably or who are on active duty. A place of reflection, pride and solace, the Memorial was dedicated in 2003. The design features two pentagons that surround a central flag. The inner ring represents the five branches of service and the outer pillars of American black granite bear the names of over 900 servicemen and women.
