## STATE OF IOWA

### FEDERAL DISASTER DECLARATION FACT SHEET

**JUNE 19, 2019**

On March 23, 2019, President Donald J. Trump granted a Major Disaster Declaration for the State of Iowa triggering the release of Federal funds to help people and communities recover from Severe Storms and Flooding that occurred March 12 – May 16, 2019. **This disaster declaration has been amended as indicated below in bold.** Details of the disaster declaration and assistance programs are as follows:

Adair, Boone, Butler, Cass, Emmet, Guthrie, Kossuth, O'Brien, Osceola, Plymouth, Tama, and Union Counties for Public Assistance [Categories C-G] (already designated for debris removal and emergency protective measures [Categories A and B], including direct federal assistance, under the Public assistance program).

Woodbury County for Public Assistance [Categories C-G] (already designated for Individual Assistance and assistance for debris removal and emergency protective measures [Categories A and B], including direct federal assistance, under the Public Assistance program).

Fayette, Hamilton, and Webster Counties for Public Assistance [Categories C-G] (already designated for debris removal and emergency protective measures [Categories A and B], including direct federal assistance, under the Public Assistance program).

Buchanan, Clayton, Clinton, Des Moines, Jackson, Jones, Lee, Mitchell, Muscatine, Ringgold, and Worth Counties for Public Assistance.

Louisa and Scott Counties for Public Assistance (already designated for Individual Assistance).

Winnebago County for Public Assistance [Categories C-G](already designated for debris removal and emergency protective measures [Categories A and B], including direct federal assistance, under the Public Assistance program).

Hazard Mitigation (HM):

(Assistance for actions taken to prevent or reduce long term risk to life and property from natural hazards):

HM-Designated Areas:

All areas in the State of Iowa are eligible to apply for assistance under the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program.

OTHER:

Additional designations may be made at a later date if requested by the State and warranted by the results of further damage assessments.
